SBR has updated based on establishment census of 2016.

8. Quality

SBR of Mongolia has fully updated from establishment census in 2017. Establishment census is one of the official statistical sources to update Mongolian SBR every 5 years. 2016 establishment census was conducted during April 1-May 1, 2016 at national level, as stated in Article 7.1 of the Law on Statistics of Mongolia and Government Resolution No.163 dated March 21, 2016. The following two methods were used in data collection of the establishment census: Electronic method: The website for establishment census (<http://aanb.nso.mn/login.aspx>) was linked to the website (<https://e-tax.mta.mn/portal>) with corporate income tax report of the General Customs and Taxation Authority (by former name) of first quarter of 2016, and data was collected during April 1-April 20, 2016. Traditional method: The enumerators collected data from establishments other than those involved in online census during April 1-30, 2016 upon personally introducing census questionnaires to management and relevant employees of establishments. Moreover, location points, where establishments carried out their activities, were compiled and geographical database was updated.
