1. Short title of work which was done (Category) Run the RIAD 4.0 Expansion project 5. Maintenance Description of work (max 4-5 sentences) Significant expansion of the database capacity in order to serve as the technical platform for maintaining all ESCB wide counterparties (i.e. lenders, borrowers and guarantors) that are in particular relevant for the new pan-European Analytical Credit ('AnaCredit') dataset. Implementation of further technical and organisational enhancements to allow the unique identification of organisational units and the management of reference data (by more than one data providing institution) in a 'cross-border' context and to better cover new supervisory-relevant counterparty information. 2. Short title of work which was done (Category) Increase coverage 2. Coverage Description of work (max 4-5 sentences) In supporting the forthcoming euro area-wide 'AnaCredit dataset on credit and credit risk' the coverage of RIAD has dramatically increased, in particular, expanding the number of non-financial corporations recorded in the register. The new RIAD 4.0 database started with 6 million counterparties, which may in the steady-state reach 10 to 12 million units. In parallel huge efforts are invested in identifying (crossborder) counterparties. 3. Short title of work which was done (Category) Enhance the data quality management 1. Roles of the SBR Description of work (max 4-5 sentences) The strengthening of the ESCB-wide data quality management has materialised in issuing a dedicated ECB Guideline (https://www.ecb.europa.eu/ecb/legal/pdf/celex 32018o0016 en txt.pdf) that for the first time summarises and presents all data collection and maintenance activities of the stakeholders (NCBs) in a single legally binding document. Quality Description of work (max 4-5 sentences) In the context of the recording of large volumes of borrowers, NCBs have loaded from May to September 2018 information on non-resident entities in RIAD. To keep unintended duplication to a minimum, a dedicated 'matching tool' helps identify and map entities in the dataset in an automated way. The logic of this functionality will be enhanced (via machine leaning) so as to process data accurately and efficiently. 2. Short title of work planned (Category) Closer link with GLEIF database 4. Data sources Description of work (max 4-5 sentences) Functionalities in the pipeline aim at an efficient synchronisation of RIAD with reference data provided by GLEIF.

Description of the challenge

The basic design of RIAD allows on the one hand processing input from more than one source per unit or attribute and on the other hand serving the needs for various business processes or stakeholders. Consequently, the operator of RIAD has to continuously monitor and improve the coordination among actors and adapt governance procedures among stakeholders, including in the Supervisory area as data providers and quality managers.

Gathering information from statistical registers and using them for purpose other than "statistical" purposes is often not possible. This is a significant hurdle as a key subset of the reference data such as names, identifiers, SNA/ESA sector codes, ISIC/NACE codes are in the public domain in most countries.
